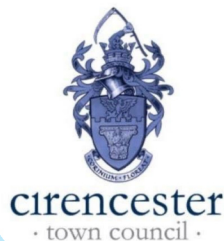

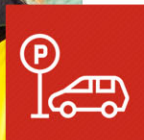
START LINE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Additional Parking:

If the college car park is full, please use one of the following nearby options:

Bathurst Estate (Old Kennels) – next door to the college (fees apply)
 What3Words: ///closer.projects.delighted

St. James Place

What3Words: ///stoppage.pays.reserved
 We recommend parking at these locations and walking to the start/finish line.

Sustainable Travel:

We encourage sustainable travel wherever possible:
 Use public transport
 Lift share with teammates or friends
 Cycle or walk if you live locally
 Help reduce congestion and your environmental impact.

Road Closures:

Due to race day road closures, many main parking areas will not be accessible. Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

No Parking Zones:

Parking is strictly prohibited in the following areas:
 Beecher Road & Victoria Road – used early in the race
 Cirencester Marketplace – no parking allowed at any time
 Vehicles parked in restricted zones may be towed. Please do not risk it.

Local Residents:

If you live nearby:
 Walk to the start line where possible
 Car share with family, teammates, or friends

 Cotswold Escapes – rural retreats within a short drive of Cirencester.

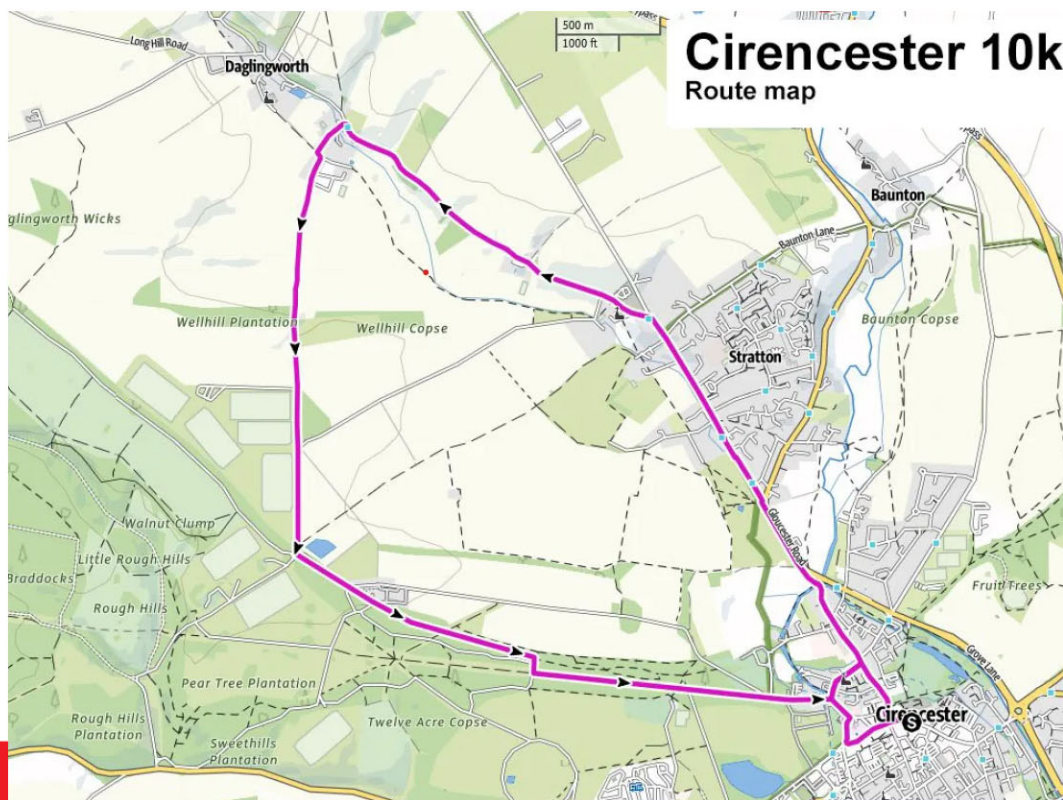

RACE ROUTE



The Cirencester 10K starts and finishes in the heart of the town at the Market Place. Runners will wind through the charming Cotswolds lanes before continuing along Gloucester Road, enjoying scenic views, and then turning back towards the town. Finally, you'll return via the Bathurst Estate, heading straight back into the Market Place.

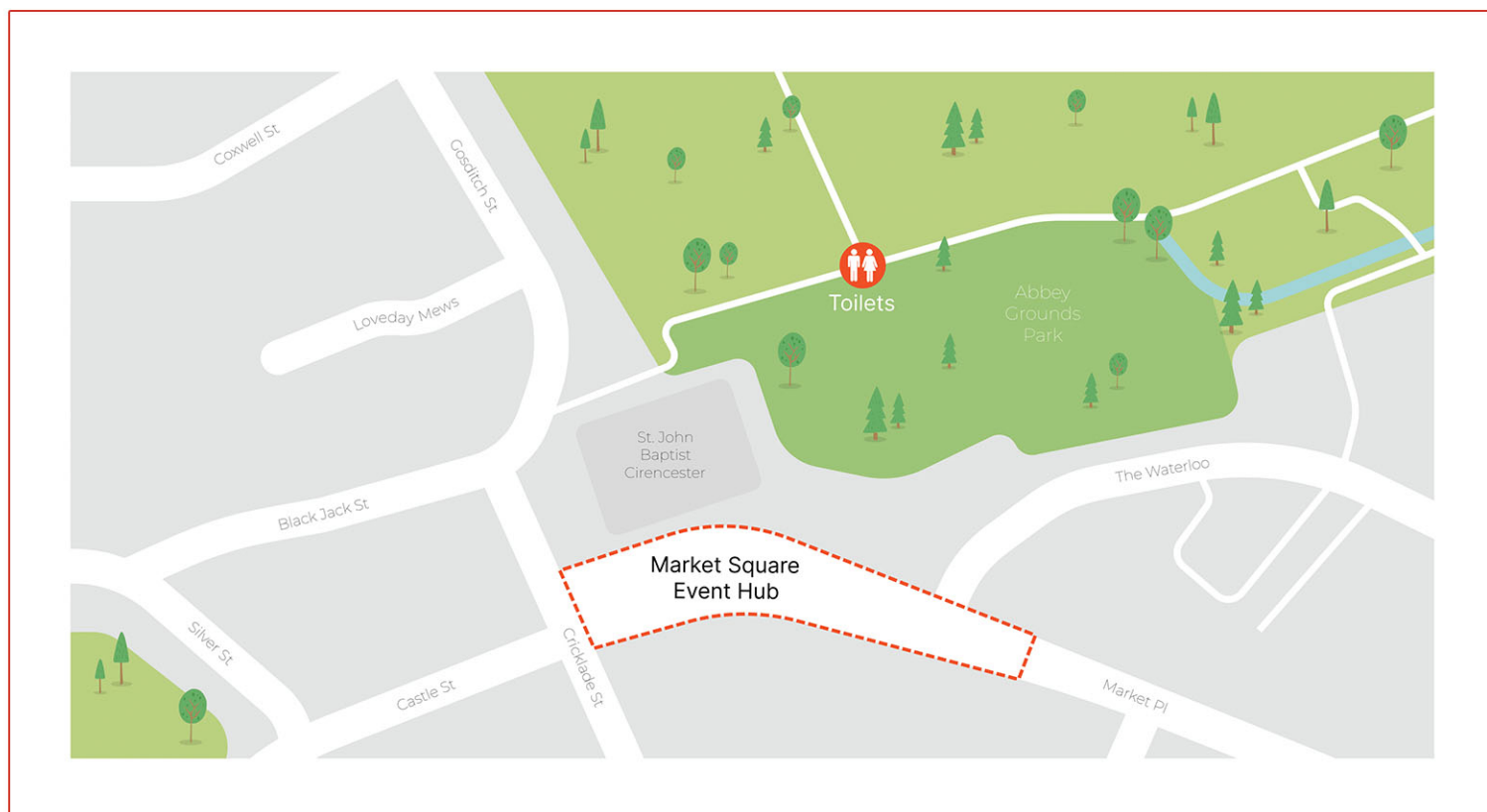


START AREA

The race will start at 09:00AM, and all participants must arrive at the venue by 08:30AM. Unfortunately, latecomers will not be able to take part in the event.

There are no allocated start pens. Please seed yourself appropriately according to your estimated finish time, with faster runners towards the front and slower runners towards the back.

Listen carefully for all race announcements.



MEDICAL POINT

OUTDOOR MEDICAL SOLUTIONS

If you did not tell us about a medical condition when you registered, or if you have received a new diagnosis since registering that we should be aware of, please let us know as soon as possible.

If you need medical assistance during the run, stop, rest, and inform the nearest volunteer, or ask another runner to inform them on your behalf.

Medical stations will be located along the route and at the finish line.



CIRENCESTER 10K**DAVE**

YOUR RACE NUMBER

Your race number, baggage tag, timing chip, and safety pins have been posted to you. Your timing chip is already attached to the back of your race number.

You **MUST** secure your race number to the front of your t-shirt or vest. Your timing chip will activate as you cross the start line, so don't worry if others start ahead of you.

Important: Without a race number, you cannot participate in the race.

If you lose or forget your race number, a limited number of spares will be available at the Information Point on race day. Replacement cost is £10 (cash only).

Do not wear someone else's race number. You must also complete the medical details on the reverse of your race number.
